Directions

Airport/train station to the hotel

The nearest airport to Amsterdam is **Schiphol**. There are direct train services to and from **Amsterdam Centraal Station**. The train journey is about 15-19 minutes and costs €3.80 for a single (note that a round trip ticket has to be used on the same day)

Both hotels are located approximately 1.5km from **Amsterdam Centraal Station** and can be easily reached by public transport. Take tram 4 in the direction of "**Station RAI**" and get off at the stop "**Rembrandtplein**". From here it's a very short walk to either hotel. Please consult the map at the end of this document.

Hotels to conference venue

From the NH Schiller hotel, cross Rembrandtplein and enter Halvemaansteeg. Cross the Bridge across the Amstel. You are now on the Kloveniersburgwal. Continue for roughly five minutes. If you reach a square with a medieval building you went too far. Please consult the map at the end of this document for more details.

From the Eden Hotel, continue along the Amstel and cross the bridge to get onto the Kloveniersburgwal. Please consult the map at the end of this document for more details.

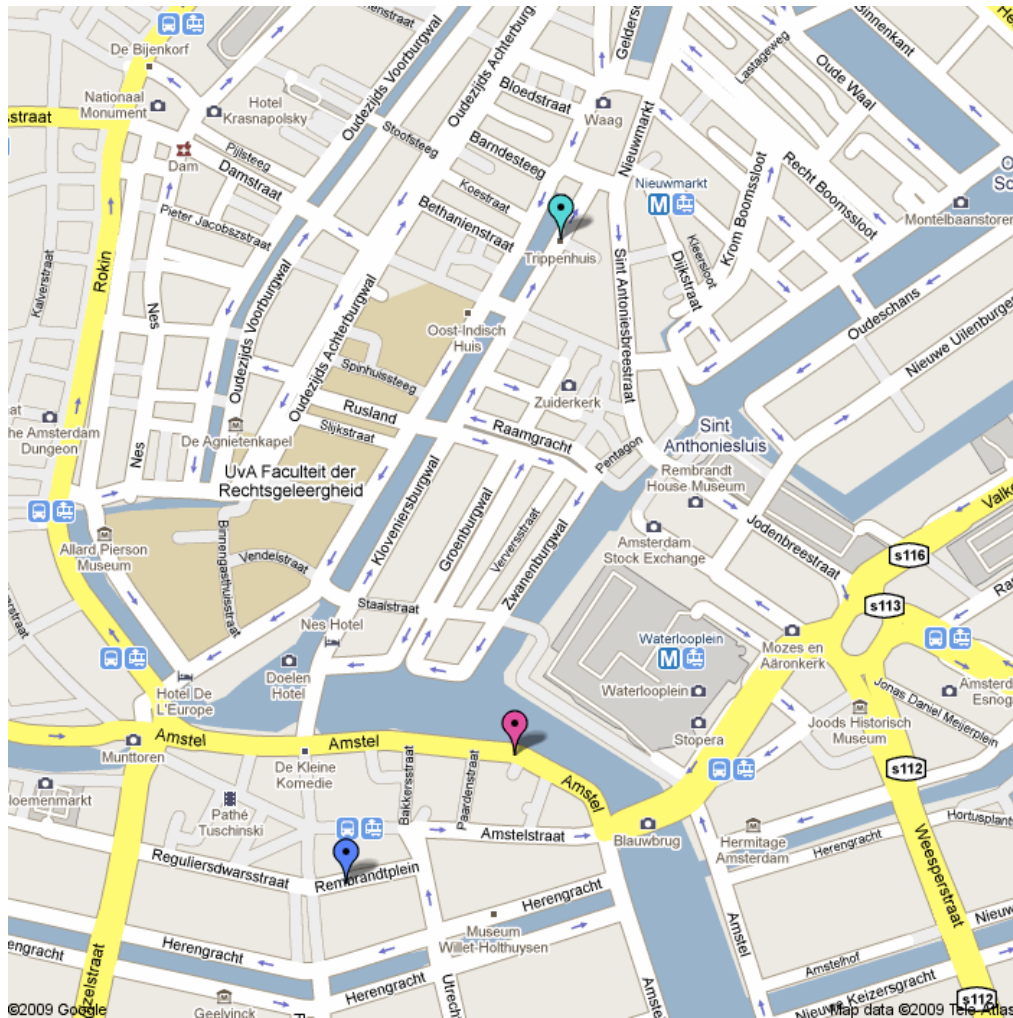
