Audio Visual Equipment

The meeting will be held in the "Jugendstilsaal" room (subject to change).

Audiovisual equipment will include data projectors (PowerPoint), flipcharts, laptop and wireless internet.

One PC is available in the lobby for participants to check e-mails and is free of charge. If participants require extended Internet use it is suggested they use the facilities at HWWI, a short distance from the conference centre.

Please ensure the final draft of your paper is received by CEPR at least one week prior to the conference. Where possible speakers should send their presentations to Caroline Daniels (cdaniels@cepr.org) at least one week in advance.

Car Parking

Car parking is not available at the conference venue. There is a public parking garage five minutes walk away. The costs are 13,00 Euro per day.

Accommodation

Participants will be staying at the conference venue, contact details are as above.

Room rates include breakfast and a three-day ticket for the public transportation system.

You can also use the sauna, steam bath and fitness room free of charge.

Organizers will pay for participants' accommodation costs in accordance with the funding granted to them. Further nights (e.g. 3rd nights, if not reimbursed through the TOM budget) can be either paid by EC or credit card, or in cash. All major credit cards will be accepted.

Reimbursement of Expenses

Participants will be provided with a copy of the CEPR expense claim form after the conference.

Directions to the Hotel

From the Airport:

- By subway-train: Starting at the Airport (between Terminal 1 and Terminal 2), please take the **suburban train** (S-bahn) line **S1** in direction U/S **Ohlsdorf**. Get off the train in **Ohlsdorf** station and change to **subway** (U-bahn) line **U1** (the blue line) in direction **Großhansdorf** or **Ohlstedt** or **Farmsen**. Get off the train at station **Stephansplatz (Oper/ CCH)** exit Esplanade/ Colonnaden. Keep walking on the Esplanade (5 minutes) and the hotel is on the right hand side.

The entire travel takes ca. 25 minutes and costs 2,70 EURO. Tickets can be purchased through the machines of the Hamburg public transport called **HVV** (ticket category number **3**) at the suburban train station. The S-bahn ticket is valid for the U-bahn as well. *Please note that you will receive a 3-days ticket for all public transport at the hotel.*

- By taxi: A **taxi** from the airport to the hotel should cost about 20-25 Euro and the travel takes about 20-30 minutes (depending on the traffic).

From the central train station (Hamburg Hauptbahnhof):

- By subway-train: Take the **subway** (U-bahn) **U1** (the blue line) in direction **Norderstedt Mitte** (or) **Ohlsdorf**. Get off the train at station **Stephansplatz (Oper/ CCH)**, exit Esplanade/ Colonnaden. Keep walking on the Esplanade (5 minutes) and the hotel is on the right hand side. The travel from the main station to the hotel takes ca. 10 minutes and costs 1,65 Euro (ticket category number **2**; tickets can be purchased through the ticket machines of the Hamburg public transport called **HVV**). *Please note that you will receive a 3-days ticket for all public transport as long as you check-in the hotel.*
- By taxi: A **taxi** from the main station to the hotel should cost about 10 Euro. The travel takes about 10-15 minutes (depending on the traffic).

Please note that also the Dammtor Bahnhof (which is another train station next to the exhibition park of Hamburg and situated in the town center) is also only 10 minutes walk away from the Hotel Baseler Hof.

Meals

Breakfast and lunches will be taken at the conference centre. There will also be two additional coffee breaks each day. Mineral water will be provided during the sessions.

Please note that non-alcoholic drinks taken with the meals are free. However, alcoholic drinks as well as drinks taken from the mini bar or consumed at the house bar have to be paid cash by the participants (Euro).

Please report in advance about any special dietary requirements. Unfortunately traditional kosher meals cannot be served.

How to get to the city centre or some fresh air?

The Esplanade (where your hotel is situated and where the conference will take place) is close to the city centre of Hamburg. The city centre is around the inner lake, called "Binnenalster".

You can walk for about 10 minutes to Jungfernstieg (S-bahn station) where you will find the Rathausmarkt (Town Hall Square). Or take the subway U1 (the blue line) from **Stephansplatz**, in direction **Großhansdorf**, (or) **Ohlstadt** (or) **Farmsen** and get off at the station **Jungfernstieg** (2 min.).

If you need some fresh air after a long journey, then you should take a walk around the outer lake (5 minutes from the hotel) called "Außenalster" which is an utterly beautiful walk of 6 km.

Some suggestions on where to eat

Dinner will be organised on Friday evening and also on Saturday for the participants who will remain until Sunday (and they will be offered by the organizers). As follows you have some suggestions about restaurants close to the hotel where you can have dinner when you arrive on the 8th:

Hamburger Fischerstuben - Colonnaden 49, 20354 Hamburg (Northern German fish specialities);

Franziskaner Restaurant - Große Theaterstr. 9; corner Colonnaden, 20354 Hamburg (original Bavarian and German specialities in a friendly Munich-like atmosphere);

"Die Kartoffelstube" Restaurant Stadtkrug - Colonnaden 45, 20354 Hamburg (German cuisine – specialities made with potatoes);

Friesenkeller Restaurant - Jungfernstieg 7, 20354 Hamburg (Friesian - Northern German cuisine).

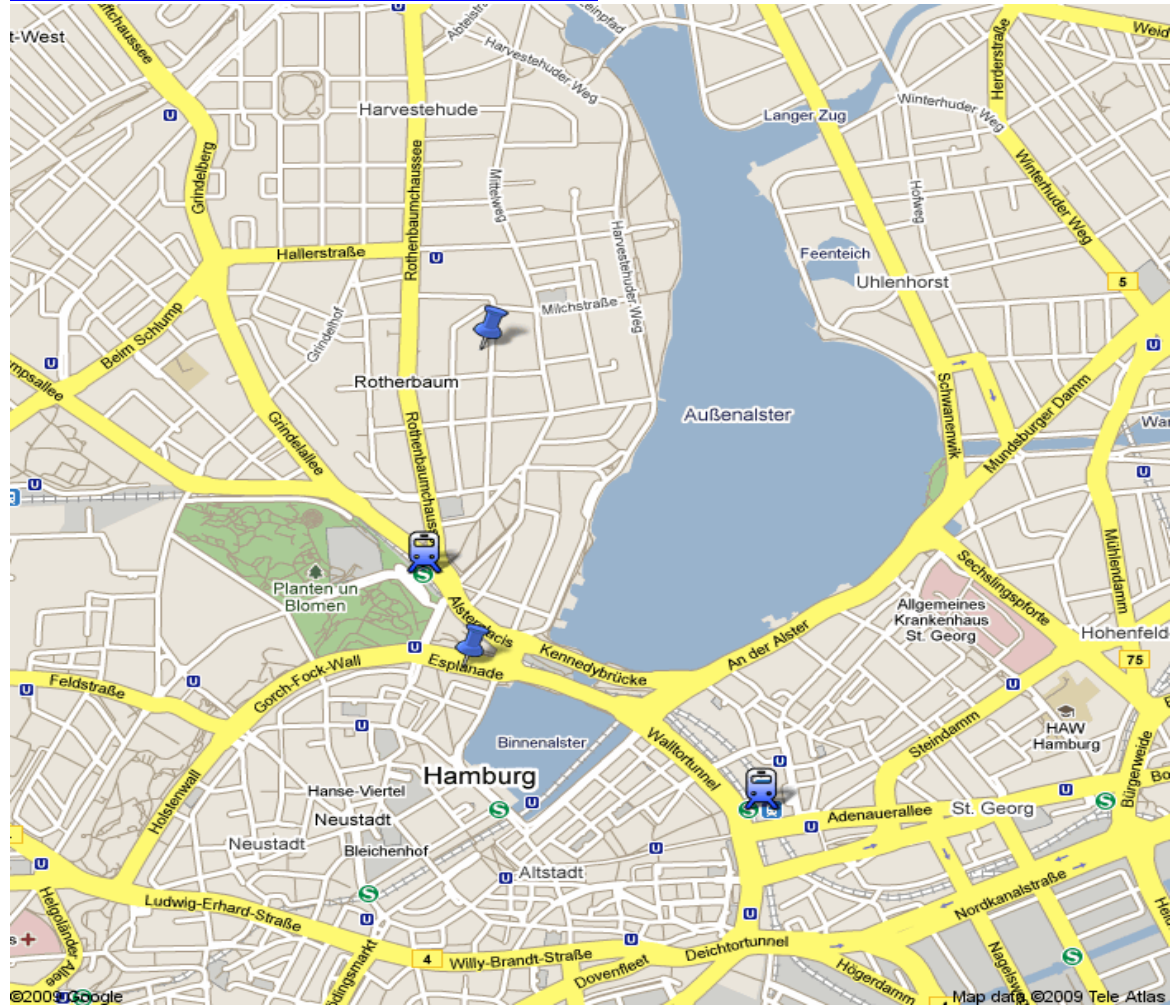
