Directions

Airport/Train Station to Hotel

For those staying at Timhotel Palais Royal or Le Louvre: From Orly Airport, take the Orlyval and then RER B to Paris, from Roissy - Charles de Gaulle, take RER B to Paris. Stop at Chatelet - Les Halles. From Gare du Nord (Eurostar), take metro line 4 (towards Porte d'Orléans) and stop at Les Halles. Both hotels are within walking distance of the metro and RER stations.

For those staying at Timhotel Palais Royal or Le Louvre: From Orly Airport, take the Orlyval and then RER B to Paris, from Roissy - Charles de Gaulle, take RER B to Paris. Stop at Chatelet - Les Halles. Take metro line 14 to Saint-Lazare.

From Gare du Nord (Eurostar), take RER E towards Haussmann – Saint Lazare (at Haussman, follow signs for Pôle Saint-Lazare).

To the Conference Venue

Conseil de la Concurrence is in the centre of Paris just across from the Louvre. Both Charles de Gaulle and Orly airport are easily accessible via the RER B (suburban train network, first take Orlyval to Antony from Orly). The nearest RER stop to the conference venue is **Chatelêt-les Halles**, where you can either walk to the venue or take metro line 14 to Pyramides.

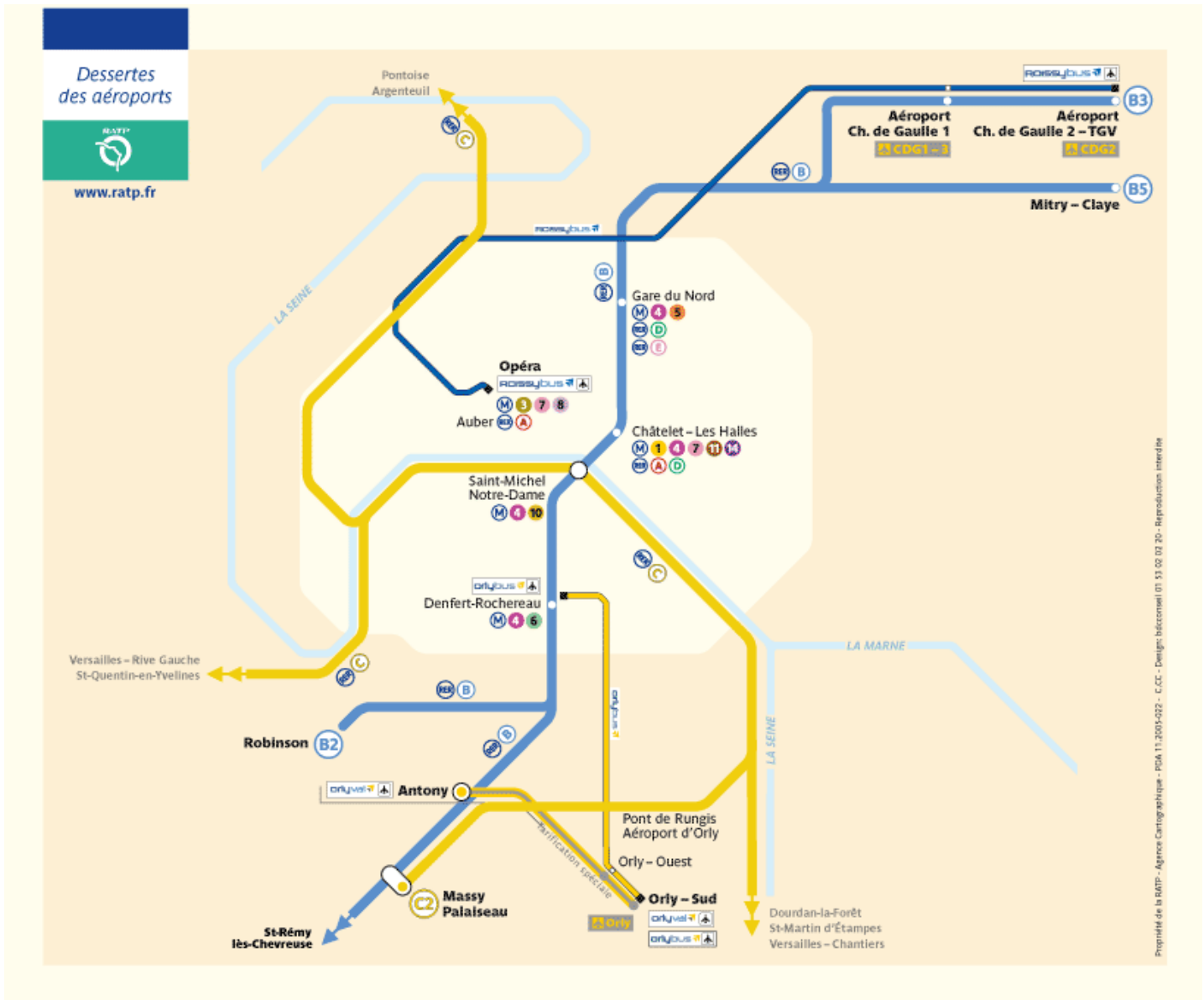
From Gare du Nord (Eurostar terminal), you can either take metro line 4 (towards Porte d'Orléans) and change at Chatelet to line 14 (towards Saint-Lazare), then stop at Pyramides. You can also walk directly from Les Halles. Another option is to walk to Gare de l'Est and take metro line 7 to Pyramides.

Access by bus: 21, 27, 39, 48, 68, 69, 72 and 95

Access by RER: Chatelet – Les Halles (A, B or D), 20-minute walk.

Access by Metro: Palais Royal – Musée du Louvre (line 1 or 7), Pyramides (line 14).

Directions from the hotels to the Conference Venue

The conference venue is a short walk from Timhotel Palais Royal and Timhotel Louvre (10-minute walk). See maps.

Timhotel Opéra-Madeleine is slightly further away, about 20-25 minutes walk-away. You can also take the metro, line 14 at Gare Saint-Lazare (next to the hotel) and stop at Pyramides (2 stops, less than 5 minutes). The cost of a metro ticket is €1.50 one way. (A block of 10 metro/bus tickets is €11.40) You can also take the bus from Saint-Lazare, line 21, 27 (both start from Saint-Lazare) or 95 (towards Porte de Vanves).

Meals

Breakfast should be taken at the hotel.

Lunch will be provided close to the conference venue.
